



After School Enrichment Program

Statement of Purpose

The purpose of Breakthrough Charter School's After School Enrichment Program is to serve the school and the community population by providing quality educational, recreational and social programs for students. The program is available to students in grades Pre-K-8. Students remain at their regular elementary schools to participate in the program.

The program further stimulates students' social, physical, and intellectual abilities through participation in activities with their school peers. The safety and security of children during the afterschool hours is of the utmost importance. Fees fund the cost for operation of school facilities during the extended hours.

Program Goals

The goals of Breakthrough Charter School's After School Enrichment Program include the following:

1. To provide quality afterschool enrichment activities.
2. To provide students a structured and safe environment that stresses responsible behavior, respect for others, and positive attitudes.
3. To provide a caring staff who will interact with the students in group and individual situations.
4. To provide communication with parents regarding their children's general well-being.

Schedule

Breakthrough's after school program will run weekly from Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday from 3:30-5:30 PM and Wednesday from 1:30-5:30. Unfortunately, we cannot offer transportation at this time. In the event of severe weather or school holidays/breaks, after school programming may be cancelled. The school leadership team will work to provide ample notice to families, if this should occur.

Cost of Attendance

While we work to secure grant funding, Breakthrough will charge \$5 a day per child. Payment should take place the first day of the school week. Currently, cash or PayPal payments are acceptable.
